### Guam International Raceway 2018 APL Smokin Wheels rules and regulations.

Off Road racing is a hazardous sport, you could be severely injured or killed, these rules and regulations are established to meet minimum, acceptable requirements and to provide orderly conduct of racing events, these rules and or regulations are in no way a guarantee against injury or death to participants, spectators or any other person or persons.

#### **Track Rules**

- 1. You must become a member of GIRMAC to race
- 2. All drivers/co-drivers must sign all registration forms. Underage entrants must have a notarized copy of parental consent form on file and must be accompanied at all events.
- 3. Do NOT cut course or corners. Do Not Run over bushes, cones or tires.
- 4. If a driver leaves the course for any reason he or she must re-enter the course as soon as safely possible without gaining a time or position advantage.
- 5. No drivers pit crew is permitted to go on the course without permission of the Race Director.
- 6. Vehicles must complete the entire lap under power to get lap credit.
- 7. Open Classes (2WD and 4WD) and Class 4 (2WD and 4WD) are NOT allowed to bump UTV's.
- 8. Do not exceed 5MPH in pit area.
- 9. Riders/Drivers are responsible for everyone associated with them or their team.
  - NOTE: Open Class is more than 4 cylinders Class 4 is 4 cylinders.

### **Ground for Disqualification**

- 1. Driving backwards on the course for any reason.
- 2. Intentionally hitting or ramming another rider or driver.
- 3. Using drugs or alcohol during practice or racing.
- 4. Making false statements on any registration form or GIRMAC document.
- 5. Verbal or physical abuse of a track official or organizer.
- 6. Fighting on GIR property.
- 7. Any action deemed worthy of disqualification by the Track Marshall.
- 8. Any entrant disqualified for any reason forfeits all prize money and or points for the event.

# Pit Rules

- 1. Nobody under 16yo is allowed in the hot pit.
- 2. At least one self-supplied 10lb fire extinguisher in your pit is required.
- 3. A dedicated extinguisher man must be on standby for each fuel stop.
- 4. Please watch your children at all times in cold pit You are responsible for their safety.
- 5. All pits must be placed with oil absorption materials and implement when necessary.
- 6. Retrieval of parts from the track is not permitted. Race officials will retrieve parts when necessary.
- 7. Repairs may not be made to vehicles while on the course unless approved by Race Director.

## **Racer Requirements**

Tech inspection will be mandatory. The track marshal has the right to insist on any changes that may need to be made prior to your race.

#### Personal Protective Equipment

- 1. You must wear a Snell approved helmet without notable cracks or damage.
- 2. Eye protection (Goggles) shatter resistant must be worn by both driver and co-driver.
- 3. Fire retardant suits are mandatory and must be worn by driver and co-driver when on the course.

# Numbers

- 1. GIRMAC is not responsible for scoring if your number is not recognizable to the scorers.
- 2. GIRMAC reserves the right to change or give entrants temporary numbers if needed.
- 3. Numbers must be visible on both sides of vehicle.

#### Vehicle Technical Requirements

- 1. Seat belts, (4 point minimum) mounting must be consistent with manufacturer guidelines.
- 2. Roll cages are required and attachment must be double steel plate or welded to chassis.
- 3. Latched anchors must have pins (cotter pins) installed.
- 4. All race vehicles must have either an on-board fire suppression system protecting the driver and co-driver or a 2.5 lb. ABC dry extinguisher within reach of the driver or co-driver while strapped in. In addition, every race vehicle must have another 2.5lb. ABC extinguisher mounted and accessible from the outside of the race vehicle.
- 5. Safety nets or hand restraints are required and must be installed as per manufacturer specs.
- 6. All race vehicles must use an approved fuel cell installed and mounted using suitable retaining methods. A metal canister containing the fuel cell is mandatory with metal straps securely attached to the chassis. The fuel cell needs to vent from above all sides.
- 7. All fuel lines must be a good condition with acceptable installation and routing with industry guidelines and procedures. Must be minimum 10" away from any moving parts or heat.
- 8. Battery must be mounted outside the driver compartment or within a metal box and a metal divider that separates the battery from the occupants unless a dry cell battery is used. The battery must be retained with metal straps. All race vehicles must have a "Master" battery switch in functioning condition that is accessible to driver and co-driver.
- 9. Two engine throttle return springs must be in place at all times.
- 10. All race vehicles must have rear facing colored taillight assemblies constant on.
- 11. Chassis shall be free of cracks and obvious structural damage.
- 12. All vehicles must have a functioning rear view mirror system.
- 13. No leaks of any fluid.
- 14. Body panels must be attached securely and in any manner to last the entire duration of the event.
- 15. No devices that appear to intentionally cause harm to another competitor.

## Practice Schedule and Rules for BUGGIES, TRUCKS AND UTV (BTU)

- 1. BTU practice is Tuesday April 10 thru Friday April 13, 8am 1pm. NO EXCEPTIONS
- 2. There will be 1 hour intervals. Open Class and Class 4 with UTV's.
- 3. Racers must have their own chase vehicle or rescue vehicle during practice.
- 4. For practice there will be only one entrance to the track.
- 5. In the event of an incident your chase vehicle can only enter the track at the same entrance as race vehicle.

Assigned Emergency Chase Vehicle Requirements – Tues-Fri Practice Sessions.

- 1. 10lb Fire Extinguisher
- 2. Two quarts of water for each race vehicle occupant.
- 3. Two emergency reflective markers or safety cones.
- 4. One tow strap with 10,000lb capacity.
- 5. Approved Red Cross emergency first aid kit.

#### Other Rules

- 1. Driver is responsible for all actions of his pit crew, family and friends.
- 2. Please do not leave trash behind in your pits.
- 3. Speed limit in pit area is 5MPH.
- 4. ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOL in pit area during the race or practice.

GIR and GIRMAC reserves the right to amend any rules based on course conditions, safety of the riders or any other circumstance that may arise.
